10	Walker Barn SJ 995737 (26.5 miles)	Riders turn left from A537 into Buxton Old Road	Warning signs on approach roads. Marshal required.	M
11	Finish near Teggs Nose Country Park (27 miles) SJ 953736	Riders finishing	Finish flag or board. Timekeeper's assistant required. Warning sign facing oncoming traffic.	M
12	After the finish	Riders returning	Clear instructions on Start Sheet indicating route to take.	L

Notes :-

Timing of events to be considered in conjunction with traffic counts.

Warnings on the Start Sheet should inform competitors :-

“Please remember this is a Mountain Timetrial, so bring some low gears, good tyres and brakes, and take care on the descents.”

“Do not congregate at the finish or distract the timekeeper.
Please keep the road clear at all times.”

“Particular care is required turning left from the A53 onto the A54 at Ladmanlow on the outskirts of Buxton ¼ mile after entering the 30 mph zone following a fast downhill section.”
