1	Before the start	Riders getting to the start	Clear instruction on Start Sheet giving directions to the start.	L
2	At the start on the A5004 in Whaley Bridge near Vaughan Road SK 010802	Riders arriving and waiting to start.	Warning signs on approach. Marshal to control competitors so that the road is unobstructed.	M
3	Where Elnor Lane joins the A5004 (1.35 miles) SK 017785	Traffic emerging from junction	Warning sign facing oncoming traffic.	M
4	At the finish near Goyts Lane. (4.5 miles) SK 032752	Riders arriving and slowing down.	Warning signs facing oncoming traffic. Finish board or flag in place. Marshal required.	M
5	After the finish	Riders returning down the hill after finishing.	Information on Start Sheet for riders to return safely.	L

## Notes :-

Timing of events to be considered in conjunction with traffic counts.

General safety advice notice to be included on Start Sheet :-

“Riders must exercise care at all times.

Observers will be present at the event.

Avoid the use of “U” turns. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.”

“Please do not park on the hill. Riders must not disturb the timekeeper at the finish. Times will be displayed as soon as possible.”
